Focus on safety as a moral obligation and "the right thing to do".





ADAPT

Learn from mistakes, make the appropriate changes, and strive for continuous improvement.

Create a culture focused on creative thinking and active listening. Respond to mistakes in a way that inspires workers to address workplace hazards and protect one another.



DEFEND

Be vigilant about identifying workplace risks and hazards, including human factors like fatigue and complacency.

Always ensure that appropriate controls are in place.
